## REGULAR COMMITTEE REPORTS

**Public Communications:** Greg Zebrowski reported that the Department of Emergency Management and Security (DEMS) is working on an integrated messaging system with FEMA.

**Business Outreach:** Greg Zebrowski reported they are moving back to in-person meetings. Work continues on community engagement and recruiting new members to the Business Emergency Operations Council.

**HMERP Exercise Subcommittee:** BC Sellers reported the Fairfax County Fire and Rescue Department recently graduated 38 persons as hazmat technicians from the department's inhouse training program. The HMERP exercise is scheduled for September 14, 2022, including the HazMat team, Fire Station 26, and Washington Gas. BC Sellers will confirm the time and report back to the FJLEPC for those members who wish to attend

**CCC Liaison:** Chairman Jolley reported he attended the CCC meeting on May 26, 2022. Discussion focused on outreach at events such as community fairs; they also discussed reaching out to regional representatives from the Boy and Girl Scouts of America.

#### RECENT INCIDENTS

BC Sellers reported no significant incidents; there were inside and outside gas leaks, a vehicle petroleum spill cleanup, and residential mercury spills.

#### **HMRT TRAINING**

BC Sellers reported that the HMRT will be purchasing better detection equipment this year for detection of weapons of mass destruction. Their chemical protection equipment is fully stocked. They are working on outreach with regional partners including the CIA, FBI, Arlington County, Loudoun County, Prince William County, and the City of Alexandria with opportunities for joint training on a regional response to events.
